
IYRA GEOGRAPHY:

IYRC (International Youth Robot Competition) is an annual youth competition in robotics, programming and digital technologies, organized by the International Youth Robot Association (IYRA).


Previously, the IYRC were held in Korea, Thailand, China, and Malaysia. The country of the IYRC 2020 was determined during the IYRC 2019 in Korea. Following the results of the IYRA member countries voting Coordination Centre of the Intergovernmental Commission on Cooperation in the Field of Computer Engineering was chosen as the organizer of the competitions in 2020, and Russia as the host country. The absolute majority of the participating countries voted for the Russian Federation.
























BACKGROUND

The Coordination Centre of the Intergovernmental Commission on Cooperation in the Field of Computer Engineering is a state institution with a **50-year history**.





MAIN ACTIVITIES






COORDINATION CENTRE'S LOCATION




The building belongs to the neoclassical style and has the status of an **object of cultural heritage** of Federal importance.


Shcherbatov apartment house (Moscow, 1913)




Shcherbatov apartment house (Moscow, 2019)
